



## Recommended Packing List Fall & Winter Time (October - March)

### What you need to Bring:

- Cloth face mask
- Sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket
- Pillow
- Work shirts (Long and short sleeve T-shirts that can get dirty)
- Work pants (Jeans or sturdy khaki pants. Shorts/sweat pants/wind pants are **not** suitable for working)
- Warm Coat
- Warm Sweatpants
- Hats, Gloves, & Scarves
- High Cut socks (to wear with boots)
- Work Gloves and Boots
- Old sneakers for roofing
- Hat and/or bandanna
- Leisure clothes (no revealing clothing, tight shirts, very short shorts or tank tops)
- Leisure shoes (tennis shoes/sandals)
- Sweatshirt or jacket (even in the summer mornings and evenings are chilly)
- Rain gear or poncho (we do work in the rain)
- Slippers or indoor shoes
- Towel & toiletries
- Modest pajamas
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Refillable water bottle
- **Photo ID and insurance card in case of emergency**

### Optional

- Healthy snacks to share with all
- Your favorite devotions and songs for prayer
- Musical instrument
- Journal, Bible and book to read
- Refillable water bottle
- A little spending money (the Nazareth Farm store sells t-shirts, bandannas, hats, etc...)
- Camera and film with your name on it (phones are not permitted as cameras)
- Frisbee, football, hacky sack and other fun games and toys
- Dirty laundry bag

### What not to bring:

Bottled water, soda pop, cell phone, CD players, i-pods, mp3's, laptops, jewelry, weapons of any kind- including swiss army knives, hair dryers, curling irons, makeup, drugs and alcohol
